Shoots & Events - August is always a busy month for the club with the Vic Frye Memorial 3-D shoot, Family Night, Milk jug shoot, and the Coon Shoot.

Again, this year we will be opening the **Vic Frye Memorial shoot** on Friday, August 4th, at 4 pm, for anyone that has weekend plans or wants to enjoy a Friday evening at the range. During this shoot we will be offering a weekend shoot pass and an all-day pass. For \$20 you can shoot the whole course all weekend, as much as you want or for \$15 you can shoot as much as you want, the entire day. A onetime pass will still cost you only \$10.

August 9 will be our **Family Night and Milk Jug shoot** so bring out your spouse, kids, and friends to enjoy some charcoal chicken, corn on the cob, plenty of salads, and deserts for a low price of just \$7/plate. New this year, in addition to our Milk Jug Shoot, we will have half the range setup with 3D targets for you and your family to shoot for FREE. Bring out your bow and show off your skills to see who can empty a milk jug the fastest. We will have a signup sheet for the Milk Jug Shoot at the front counter on Family Night.

Also, if you shoot a large whitetail buck (in state kill) have your antlers measured by Chris Bergeman, our official scorer. He must score your buck to become eligible for prizes. Thanks everyone, I hope your season is safe and memorable.
